

# Craigie Bridge Rehabilitation

### Q: What's happening?

The Craigie Bridge (at Museum of Science) will be reconstructed and the DCR is holding a public meeting. This is the first time the public and LivableStreets will see plans, already at 90% design! This is the only opportunity for us to express our views and desires.

### Q: Why attend this meeting?

To demand safe bicycle and pedestrian accommodations on a bridge that is a key connection between Boston and Cambridge & Somerville, and between the Charles River paths.

### Q: Is the DCR considering bicycles and pedestrians?

We're not sure about the details. They plan to widen the sidewalk for bicyclists and pedestrians. We don't know if bicyclists are being accommodated on the roadway.

### Q: What should the ideal design include?

- On-street bicycle lanes
- Better bicycle and pedestrian connections at ends of bridge, particularly at Leverett Circle (ex. a bike box)
- A well-designed multi-use path (not just a sidewalk), given the constraints at hand.
